Entrance Requirements

- 1) Complete the admission application packet and submit a \$50.00 non-refundable fee (U.S. dollars) made payable to Nova Southeastern University (NSU).
- 2) Official transcripts from **all** previously attended academic institutions. An official transcript indicating conferral of a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution is required.
- 3) A minimum **2.5** cumulative grade point average (CGPA- required for all students).
- 4) Two letters of recommendation from professional and/or educational sources.
- 5) Application essay.
- 6) Copy of a valid FL DOE Professional Educator's Certificate or Waiver Form stating that student does not hold a certificate.

Benchmarks

1. Matriculation after the completion of the first four courses with a grade of "B" or better.
2. Successfully pass the General Knowledge sub-test of the FTCE within the first year of the program and prior to matriculation.
3. Maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA.
4. Be matriculated to be eligible for practicum.
5. Be matriculated and successfully completed the following courses to be eligible for internship:
 - a) PYCL 502 Counseling Theories and Practice
 - b) PYCL 504 Counseling Skills
 - c) PYCL 512 Human Growth and Development
 - d) PYCL 515 Principles of School Counseling
 - e) PYCL 550 Contemporary Clinical Interventions
 - f) PYCL 570 Ethical, Legal and Professional Issues for Counselors
 - g) PYCL 635 Group Theory and Practice
 - h) PYCL 665 School Consultation Skills
 - i) PYCL 685 School Counseling Practicum (**must be completed with a grade of "B" or better**).
6. Complete and file an application for practicum and internship and receive approval prior to registering for these courses.
7. Complete 100 hours of practicum field experience and 600 of internship field experience prior to graduation. These courses must be completed with a grade of "B" or better.
8. Complete all remaining FTCE testing requirements for specialization (Professional Education Test and Guidance and Counseling specialty test)

Exit Requirements

1. Satisfactory completion of all course requirements, a portfolio, and all Florida Educator Accomplished Practices
2. Florida Teacher Certification Examinations (FTCE) – Passing scores on the following areas:
 - a. General Knowledge Test (GK)
 - b. Professional Education Test (PEd)
 - c. Subject Area Exam (SAE) in Guidance and Counseling (PK-12)
