




DESCRIBE SPECIFIC SITE REQUIREMENTS:

Mandatory Trainings/Meetings (days/hours):

Orientation is second week of August (3 days), and Monday afternoon supervision with coordinators and practicum director (3 hours each week). Individual supervision each week (1 hr).

Required Training Prerequisites (classes, degrees, experience, etc. that is outside of regular required curriculum/grades):

Experience with children and behavioral therapies preferred. Occasional travel to schools may be required/necessary.

Supervision Requirements: <u>None specifically other than being prepared</u> Specific Evening Hours Requirements: <u>None specifically</u> Direct Clinical Contact (hours/week): <u>Mininum 4-6 hours per week, more in the spring, typically.</u>

Reminders

▶ IT IS CRITICAL TO YOU READ AND MEET THE REQUIREMENTS FOR EACH SITE BEFORE SELECTING IT.

- We review students' eligibility before assigning them. If you do no meet the requirements for a site we cannot assign you there and you have wasted 1 or more of your 14 site selections.
- Immediately after you submit your application, a copy will be sent to the Office of Clinical Training and a copy will be sent to your NSU email address.
- Sometime in late Jan to early Feb we will notify students of their assigned practicum placements.
 - BROSWERS THAT CAN BE USED TO SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION: You can only use Outlook, Chrome, or Firefox. The Explorer browser cannot be used as it comes up with errors and will be rejected.
- THE PORTAL IS CORRECT! Do not be alarmed if some sites are not listed under a certain year.
- Intensive Supervisors: For 1st and 2nd year students not at a PSC faculty site, After sending out practicum assignments we will send out intensive supervisor assignments. Elective students can ask for an intensive supervisor, but it will cost 1 credit hour.
