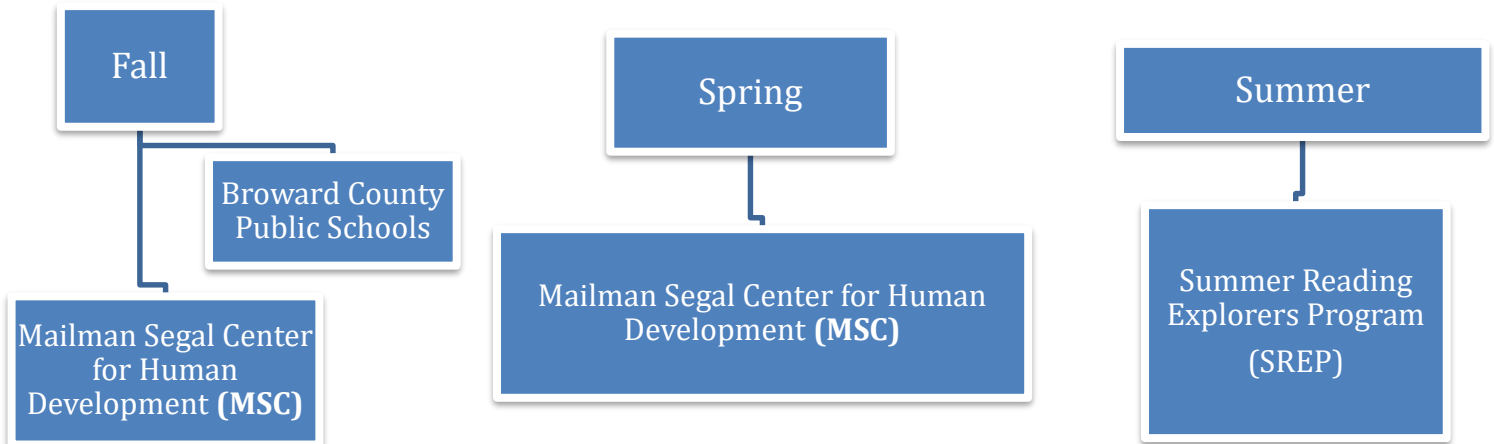


# Practicum Timeline

## FIRST YEAR (480 hours)



### Broward County Public Schools (BCPS)

- Candidates are assigned a supervisor who is a practicing school psychologist in the 6<sup>th</sup> largest school district in the country
- Candidates shadow assessments, observations, interventions, as well as IEP, ESE and RTI meetings

### Mailman Segal Center for Human Development (MSC)

- Candidates are placed at MSC at either the Baudhuin Pre-School, internationally recognized model program for children with ASD or the Family Center infant-toddler preschool (total 2000 students)
- Candidates provide classroom support, social skills, child study team involvement, parent training and assessment

### School-Related Psychological Assessments and Clinical Interventions (SPACI)

- Candidates shadow a second year student on clinical cases
- Candidates participate in parent and child interviews, assessments, interventions, school observations, etc.

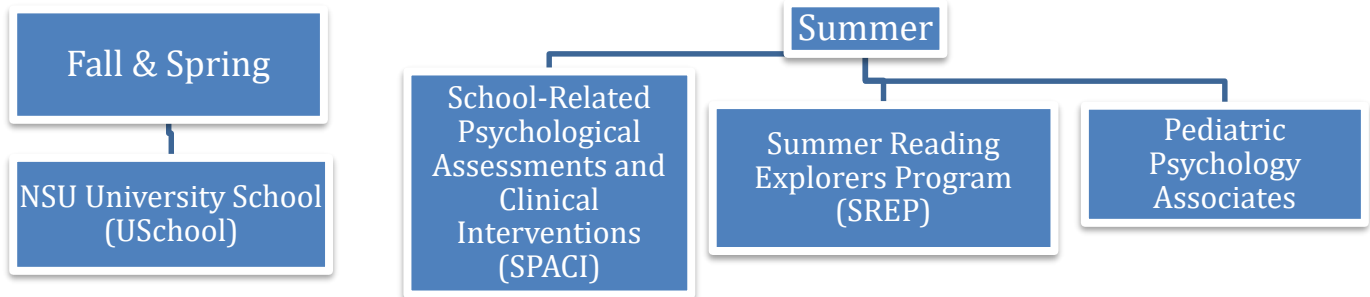
### Miami Dade County Summer Reading Explorers Program (SREP)

- Candidates serve as Assessment Specialists administering reading measures to determine intervention in collaboration with Miami-Dade County Public Schools (4<sup>th</sup> largest US school district) and Florida International University (FIU)
- Children range from five to eight years of age and attend low-performing district schools

- Candidates provide individual, group counseling and/or skills training, consultation with parents, teachers, and administration, teacher in-service training, progress monitoring, and targeted assessment
- Candidates serve 1800-plus Preschool through 12<sup>th</sup> grade students and their families

**School Psychology-related Assessment, Consultation, and Intervention Clinic (SPACI)**

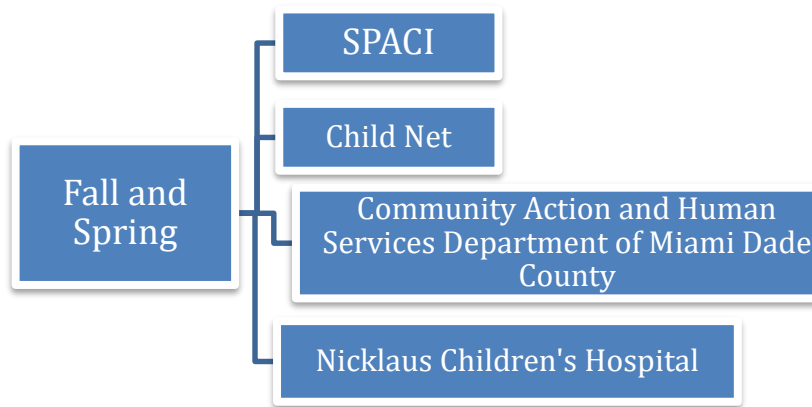
**PEDIATRIC PSYCHOLOGY ASSOCIATES**

- Candidates carry-out parent, child, and family interviews; identify psychological measures and/or other assessment methods to answer referral questions; administer tests and score them reliably; interpret and write up test results; formulate recommendations, provide individualized feedback; implement treatment or other interventions, and run groups for children and families with a variety of health, behavior, emotional, or psychological difficulties.

### CHILD NET

- ChildNet provides foster care, adoption, and family preservation services for 4,400-plus children and caregivers
- Candidates provide clinical support for children, adolescents, and families in care, comprehensive assessments, targeted assessments, inter-professional collaboration, as well as recommendations to the courts

### COMMUNITY ACTION AND HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT OF MIAMI DADE COUNTY

- Candidates respond to mental-health referrals for HeadStart students, including initial assessment, classroom intervention, individual and family interventions, and referral
- Candidates provide initial counseling and early intervention services to adult and child victims of domestic violence

### NICKLAUS CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL

- Candidates complete developmental, psychoeducational, and psychological evaluations with children ages 2-21. Candidates attend weekly didactic trainings with colleagues.

## Diversity at Practicum Sites

- 29% Hispanic
- 29% African American
- 34% Caucasian
- 3% Asian
- 3% Other

#### Summer Reading Explorers Program (SREP)

- Targets over 2,000 culturally and linguistically diverse young students from at-risk urban communities
- Native Haitian-Creole and Spanish speakers

#### Mailman Segal Center (MSC)

- Birth-Pre-K
- 35% Caucasian
- 21% African American
- 35% Hispanic
- 5% Asian
- 5% Multi-Racial

#### University School (USchool)

- Diverse backgrounds, including many students from the Native American Seminole Tribe

#### Child Net

- 80% of the children and families who are served through ChildNet are from diverse backgrounds
